Solemn Act of Consecration to the Immaculate Heart

by Pope Pius XII

Most Holy Virgin Mary, tender Mother of men, to fulfill the desires of the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the request of the Vicar of Thy Son on earth, I consecrate myself and my family to Thy Sorrowful and Immaculate Heart, O Queen of the Most Holy Rosary, and I recommend to Thee all the people of our country and of all the world. Please accept my consecration, dearest Mother, and use me as Thou wish to accomplish Thy designs in the world.

O Sorrowful and Immaculate Heart of Mary, Queen of the Most Holy Rosary, and Queen of the World, rule over me, together with the Sacred Heart of Jesus Christ, my King. Save me from the spreading flood of modern paganism; kindle in my heart and home the love of purity, the practice of a virtuous life, an ardent zeal for souls, and a desire to pray the Rosary more faithfully. I come with confidence to Thee, O Throne of Grace and Mother of Fair Love. In flame me with the same Divine Fire which has inflamed Thine own Sorrowful and Immaculate Heart. Make my heart and home Thy shrine, and through me, make the Heart of Jesus, together with Thy rule, triumph in every heart and home. Amen.

Novena Prayer to the Divine Infant King

All-powerful Infant, O Jesus, I implore Thee again, assist me in this need. Grant me the grace of possessing Thee eternally with Mary and Joseph and of adoring Thee with the angels in the Heavenly Court. Amen.

Eleventh Sunday after Pentecost

INTROIT: Ps. 67: 6-7,36

God in His holy place; God who maketh men of one mind to dwell in a house; He shall give power and strength to His people. (Ps.) Let God arise and let His enemies be scattered: and let them that hate Him flee from before His face. Glory be. God in His holy place...

COLLECT

O almighty and eternal God, who in the abundance of Thy loving-kindness art wont to give beyond both the deserts and desires of those who humbly pray; pour down upon us Thy mercy, forgiving us those things of which our conscience is afraid, and granting us those blessings which we dare not presume to ask. Through Our Lord.

EPISTLE: *I Cor. 15: 1-10*

A reading from Paul the Apostle to the Corinthians

Brethren, I make known unto you the Gospel which I preached to you, which also you have received and wherein you stand, by which also you are saved, if you hold fast after what manner I preached unto you, unless you have believed in vain. For I delivered unto you first of all, which I also received, how that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures; and that He was buried, and that He rose again the third day according to the Scriptures; and that He was seen by Cephas, and after that by the eleven. Then was He seen by more than five hundred brethren at once; of whom many remain until this present, but some are fallen asleep. After that He was seen by James, then by all the Apostles. And last of all He was seen by me, as by one born out of due time. For I am the least of the Apostles, who am not worthy to be called an Apostle, because I persecuted the Church of God. But by the grace of

God I am what I am; and His grace in me hath not been void.

GRADUAL: Ps. 27: 7,1 In God hath my heart confided, and I have been helped; and my flesh hath flourished again; and with my will I will give praise to Him. Unto Thee will I cry, O Lord: O depart not from me.

ALLELUIA: Ps. 80: 2,3 Alleluia, alleluia. Rejoice to God our helper; sing aloud to the God of Jacob; take a pleasant psalm with the harp. Alleluia.

GOSPEL: *MK. 7: 31-37* +*Continuation of the Holy Gospel according to St. Mark*

At that time, Jesus going out to the coasts of Tyre, came by Sidon to the sea of Galilee, through the midst of the coasts of Decapolis. And they bring to Him one deaf and dumb, and they besought Him that He would lay His hand upon him. And taking him from the multitude apart, He put His fingers into his ears, and spitting, He touched his tongue; and looking up to heaven, He groaned and said to him: Ephpheta, that is, Be thou opened: and immediately his ears were opened, and the string of his tongue was loosed, and he spoke right. And He charged them that they should tell no man: but the more He charged them so much the more a great deal did they publish it; and so much the more did they wonder, saying: He hath done all things well; He hath made both the deaf to hear, and the dumb to speak.

OFFERTORY: Ps. 29: 2-3

I will extol Thee, O Lord, for Thou hast upheld me; and hast not made my enemies to rejoice over me: O Lord, I have cried to Thee, and Thou hast healed me.

SECRET: Look down in mercy upon the lowliness of our service, we beseech Thee, O Lord, upon our service; that what we offer may be a gift acceptable unto Thee, and a support to us in our weakness. Through Our Lord.

COMMUNION: *Pr. 3: 9-10* Honor the Lord with thy substance, and with the first of all thy fruits: and thy barns shall be filled with abundance, and thy presses shall run over with wine.

POSTCOMMUNION: Having received thy holy sacrament, we beseech Thee, O Lord, that we may feel supported in soul and body, that being saved in both, we may glory in the fullness of the heavenly remedy. Through Our Lord.

Immaculate Heart of the Blessed Virgin Mary

INTROIT: Hebrews 4:16

Let us come with confidence to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and may find grace in seasonable aid. (P.T. Alleluia, alleluia.) *Ps. 44. 2.* My heart hath uttered a good word: I speak my works to the King. Glory be. Let us come with confidence to the throne of grace.

COLLECT

ALMIGHTY everlasting God, who in the heart of the blessed Virgin Mary didst prepare a dwelling worthy of the Holy Ghost; grant in Thy mercy, that we who with devout minds celebrate the festival of that immaculate heart, may be able to live according to Thine own Heart. Through our Lord ... in the unity of the same Holy Ghost ...

EPISTLE: Eccles. 24, 23-31

As the vine I have brought forth a pleasant odor, and my flowers are the fruit of honor and riches. I am the mother of fair love, and of fear, and of knowledge, and of holy hope. In me is all grace of the way and of the truth, in me is all hope of life and of virtue. Come over to me, all ye that desire me, and be filled with my fruits; for my spirit is sweet above honey, and mine inheritance above honey and the honey-comb. My memory is unto everlasting generations. They that eat me, shall yet hunger; and they that drink me, shall yet thirst. He that hearkeneth to me shall not be confounded, and they that work by me shall not sin. They that explain me shall have life everlasting.

GRADUAL: Ps. 12:6

My heart shall rejoice in Thy salvation: I will sing to the Lord, Who giveth me good things: yea I will sing to the name of the Lord the most High. (*Ps. 44. 18.*) They shall remember Thy name throughout all generations. Therefore shall people praise thee for ever.

ALLELUIA: Luke 1: 46, 47

Alleluia, alleluia. My soul doth magnify the Lord and my spirit hath rejoiced in God my Savior. Alleluia.

GOSPEL: Jn. 19: 25-27

At that time there stood by the cross of Jesus His Mother, and His Mother's sister, Mary of Cleophas, and Mary Magdalen. When Jesus therefore had seen His Mother and the disciple standing whom He loved, He saith to His Mother: Woman, behold thy son. After that,

He saith to the disciple: Behold thy mother. And from that hour, the disciple took her to his own.

OFFERTORY: Luke 1:46

My spirit hath rejoiced in God my Savior: because He that is mighty hath done great things to me and holy is His Name. (P.T. Alleluia.)

SECRET:

We who offer to Thy majesty the Lamb without blemish, beseech Thee, O Lord, that our hearts may be kindled by that divine fire which so ineffably inflamed the heart of the blessed Virgin Mary. Through the same Jesus Christ, Thy Son ...

COMMUNION: John 19: 27

Jesus saith to His mother: Woman, behold thy son. After that, He saith to the disciple: Behold thy mother. And from that hour, the disciple took her to his own.

POSTCOMMUNION:

Refreshed by these divine gifts we humbly beseech Thee, O Lord, that by the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary whose immaculate heart we now solemnly celebrate, we may be delivered from present dangers and obtain the joys of eternal life. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, Thy Son, Who lives and reigns with Thee in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, forever.
