Today, we take up a <u>second collection to support</u> the International Seminary of the Institute of <u>Christ the King Sovereign Priest</u>, which is the seminary for all future priests of the Institute.

The seminary, a 17th century villa, was built for the Martelli Family as a summer home, and following the death of the last two daughters of the family, was transformed within the last 30 years into a seminary. Located 10 miles outside of Florence, Italy, only a few hours from the Eternal City, seminarians are immersed in the traditional formation that formed priests for millennia in prayer, study, and manual labor.

Our seminary is supported financially only by these second collections, seminary tuition, and our generous donors. There are nearly 100 seminarians of the Institute and each is not always able to offset the costs of his formation.

Please continue to keep these young men in your daily prayers as they thank you for your prayerful and financial support.

SECOND SUNDAY AFTER EASTER (GOOD SHEPHERD SUNDAY)

INTROIT: Ps. 32: 5,6,1 The earth is full of the mercy of the Lord, alleluia: by the word of the Lord the heavens were established, alleluia, alleluia. (Ps) Rejoice in the Lord, O ye just; praise becometh the upright. Glory be... The earth...

COLLECT: O God, Who, by the humility of Thy Son, didst lift up a fallen world, grant unending happiness to Thy faithful: that those whom Thou hast snatched from the perils of endless death, Thou mayest cause to rejoice in everlasting joys. Through the same Our Lord.

EPISTLE: I Pet. 2: 21-25 Dearly beloved: Christ suffered for us, leaving you an example, that you should follow His steps, Who did no sin, neither was guile found in His mouth. Who when He was reviled, did not revile: when He suffered, He threatened not, but delivered Himself to him that judged Him unjustly: Who His own self bore our sins in His body upon the tree: that we, being dead to sins, should live to justice: by Whose stripes you were healed. For you were as sheep going astray, but you are now converted to the Shepherd and Bishop of your souls.

PASCHAL ALLELUIA: Alleluia, alleluia. On the day of My Resurrection, saith the Lord, I will go before you into Galilee. Alleluia. After eight days, the doors being shut, Jesus stood in the

midst of His disciples and said: Peace be to you. Alleluia.

GOSPEL: Jn. 20: 19-31 At that time, Jesus said to the Pharisees: I am the good Shepherd. The good shepherd giveth His life for His sheep. But the hireling, and he that is not the shepherd, whose own the sheep are not, seeth the wolf coming, and leaveth the sheep, and fleeth: and the wolf catcheth and scattereth the sheep: and the hireling fleeth, because he is a hireling and he hath no care for the sheep. I am the good Shepherd: and I know Mine, and Mine know Me, as the Father knoweth Me, and I know the Father: and I lay down my life for My sheep. And other sheep I have that are not of this fold: them also I must bring, and they shall hear My voice, and there shall be one fold and one shepherd.

OFFERTORY: Ps. 62: 2,5 O God, my God, to Thee do I watch at break of day: and in Thy name I will lift up my hands, alleluia.

SECRET: May this holy offering, O Lord, always bring to us Thy healing blessing: that what it represents in a mystery, it may accomplish with power. Through Our Lord.

PREFACE FOR EASTERTIDE: It is truly meet and just, right and for our salvation, at all times to praise Thee, O Lord, but more gloriously at this time above others when Christ our Pasch was sacrificed. For He is the true Lamb Who took away the sins of the world: Who by dying destroyed our death, and by rising again hath restored us to life. And therefore with Angels and Archangels, with Thrones and Dominations, and with all the hosts of the heavenly army, we sing a hymn to Thy glory, evermore saying: Holy, Holy, Holy...

COMMUNION: Jn. 10: 14 I am the good Shepherd, alleluia: and I know My sheep, and Mine know Me, alleluia, alleluia.

POSTCOMMUNION: Grant unto us, we beseech Thee, almighty God, that we who receive the grace of new life, may ever glory in Thy gift. Through our Lord...

ST. GIANNA BERETTA MOLLA

INTROIT: Ps. 118: 75, 120, 1 I know, O Lord, that Thy judgments are equity, and in Thy truth Thou hast humbled me: pierce Thou my flesh with Thy fear, I am afraid of Thy judgments. Alleluia, alleluia. (Ps) Blessed are the undefiled in the way who walk in the law of the Lord. Glory be. I know, O Lord...

COLLECT: Hear us, O God our Savior: and as we rejoice in the feast of blessed Gianna Beretta Molla, so we may learn a filial devotion to Thee. Through the same our Lord.

EPISTLE: Prov. 31: 10-31 Who shall find a valiant woman? Far and from the uttermost coasts is the price of her. The heart of her husband trusteth in her, and he shall have no need of spoils. She will render hem good, and not evil, all the days of her life. She hath sought wool and flax, and hath wrought by the counsel of her hands. She is like the merchant's ship, she bringeth her bread from afar. And she hath risen in the night, and given a prey to her household, and victuals to her maidens. She hath considered a field, and bought it: with the fruit of her hand she hath planted a vineyard. She hath girded her loins with strength, and hath strengthened her arm. She hath tasted and seen that her traffic is good: her lamp shall not be put out in the night. She hath put out her hand to strong things, and her fingers have taken hold of the spindle. She hath opened her hand to the needy, and stretched out her hands to the poor. She shall not fear for her house in the cold of snow: for all her domestics are clothed with double garments. She hath made for herself clothing of tapestry: fine linen and purple is her covering. Her husband is honorable in the gates, when he sitteth among the senators of the land. She made fine linen and sold it, and delivered a girdle to the Chanaanite. Strength and beauty are her clothing, and she shall laugh in the latter day. She hath opened her mouth to wisdom, and the law of clemency is on her tongue. She hath looked well to the paths of her house, and hath not eaten her bread idle. Her children rose up, and called her blessed: her husband, and he praised her. Many daughters have gathered together riches: thou hast surpassed them all. Favor is deceitful, and beauty is vain: the woman that feareth the Lord, she shall be praised. Give her of the fruit of her hands: and let her works praise her in the gates.

PASCHAL ALLELUIA: Ps. 44: 5 Alleluia, alleluia. With

thy comeliness and thy beauty set out, proceed prosperously, and reign. Alleluia. Because of truth, and meekness, and justice: and thy right hand shall conduct thee wonderfully. Alleluia.

GOSPEL: Mt. 13: 44-52 At that time, Jesus spoke to His disciples this parable: The Kingdom of heaven is like unto a treasure hidden in a field. Which a man having found, hid it, and for joy thereof goeth and selleth all that he hath, and buyeth that field. Again the kingdom of heaven is like to a merchant seeking good pearls. Who, when he had found one pearl of great price, went his way, and sold all that he had, and bought it. Again the kingdom of heaven is like to a net cast into the sea, and gathering together of all kind of fishes. Which, when it was filled, they drew out, and sitting by the shore, they chose out the good into vessels, but the bad they cast forth. So shall it be at the end of the world: the angels shall go out, and shall separate the wicked from among the just, and shall cast them into the furnace of fire: there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth. Have ye understood all these things? They say to him: Yes. He said unto them: Therefore every scribe instructed in the kingdom of heaven is like to a man that is a householder, who bringeth forth out of his treasure new things and old.

OFFERTORY: Ps. 44: 3 Grace is poured abroad in thy lips: therefore hath God blessed thee for ever. Alleluia.

SECRET: May this sacrifice of Thy dedicated people be accepted by Thee, O Lord, in honor of Thy Saints: to whose merits we attribute the help afforded us in tribulation. Through our Lord.

COMMUNION: Ps. 44: 8 Thou hast loved justice and hated iniquity: therefore God, they God, hast

anointed thee with the oil of gladness above thy fellows. Alleluia.

POSTCOMMUNION:

Thou hast filled Thy household, O Lord, with holy gifts: do Thou cherish us always, through the intercession of her whose festival we are keeping. Through our Lord.
