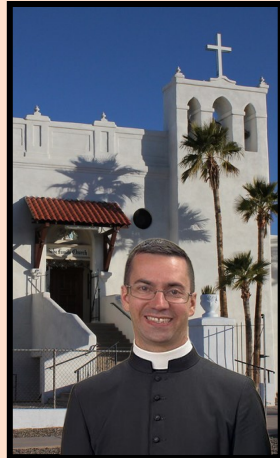

### **VISIT OF BISHOP KICANAS** **& PRAYER INTENTION**

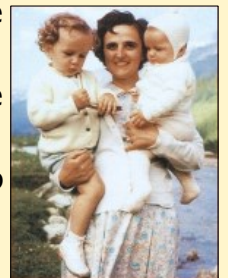

Sursum Corda is Latin for "Lift Up Your Hearts!" There is nothing more profound and encouraging than Catholic friendship - lifting each other up in our Catholic Faith, encouraging others to strive for sanctity in our everyday lives, and ultimately to extend the reign of Christ in society. This is done through the use of the Liturgy, faith discussions guided by the Canons of the Institute, various fun activities, and charity work throughout the year. Sursum Corda usually meets once a month. All are welcome to join us - whether single, married, or considering a religious vocation.



#### Thought from St. Francis de Sales:

My God, could there be any greater blindness than ours? Full of miseries and vileness, we want to appear and to be esteemed as someone really important! It is our self-love which so blinds us! God grants us a wonderful grace when He enlightens us to know our abjection, because the knowledge of our miseries and defects is a sign of conversion of heart. Anyone who wants to know himself does not want to be esteemed. If he is considered imperfect and treated as such, he is not upset. He has been cured of his blindness.

#### ***St. Francis de Sales speaks about Sunday Vespers...***

Furthermore, my child, you should endeavor to assist at the Offices, Hours, Vespers, etc., as far as you are able, especially on Sundays and Festivals, days which are dedicated to God, wherein we ought to strive to do more for His Honor and Glory than on others. You will greatly increase the fervor of your devotion by so doing, even as did Saint Augustine, who tells us in his Confessions, that in the early days of his conversion he was touched to the quick, and his heart overflowed in happy tears, when he took part in the Offices of the Church. Moreover (let me say it here once for all), there is always more profit and more consolation in the public Offices of the Church than in private acts of devotion, God having willed to give the preference to communion in prayer over all individual action.

I say the same concerning all public services and prayers, in which, as far as possible, each one of us is bound to contribute the best example we can for our neighbor's edification, and our hearty desire for God's Glory and the general good of all men.

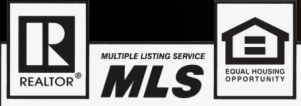

# MONTH OF OUR LADY OF SORROWS

O God, come to my assistance.

*O Lord, make haste to help me.*

Glory be... *As it was...*

1. I grieve for thee, O Mary most sorrowful, in the affliction of thy tender heart at the prophecy of the holy and aged Simeon. Dear Mother, by thy heart so afflicted, obtain for me the virtue of humility and the Gift of the Holy Fear of God. Hail Mary...

2. I grieve for thee, O Mary most sorrowful, in the anguish of thy most affectionate heart during the flight into Egypt and thy sojourn there. Dear Mother, by thy heart so troubled, obtain for me the virtue of generosity, especially toward the poor, and the Gift of Piety. Hail Mary...

3. I grieve for thee, O Mary most sorrowful, in those anxieties which tried thy troubled heart at the loss of thy dear Jesus in the Temple. Dear Mother, by thy heart so full of anguish, obtain for me the virtue of chastity and the Gift of Knowledge. Hail Mary...

4. I grieve for thee, O Mary most sorrowful, in the consternation of thy heart at meeting Jesus as He carried His Cross. Dear Mother, by thy heart so troubled, obtain for me the virtue of patience and the Gift of Fortitude. Hail Mary...

5. I grieve for thee, O Mary most sorrowful, in the martyrdom which thy

generous heart endured in standing near Jesus in His agony on the Cross. Dear Mother, by thy afflicted heart, obtain for me the virtue of temperance and the Gift of Counsel. Hail Mary...

6. I grieve for thee, O Mary most sorrowful, in the wounding of thy compassionate heart, when the side of Jesus was struck by the lance before His Body was removed from the Cross. Dear Mother, by thy heart thus transfixed, obtain for me the virtue of fraternal charity and the Gift of Understanding. Hail Mary...

7. I grieve for thee, O Mary most sorrowful, for the pangs that wrenched thy most loving heart at the burial of Jesus. Dear Mother, by thy heart sunk in the bitterness of desolation, obtain for me the virtue of diligence and the Gift of Wisdom. Hail Mary...

*V. Pray for us, O Virgin most Sorrowful.*

*R. That we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.*
