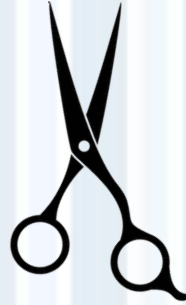

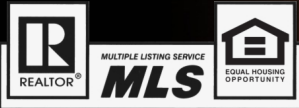

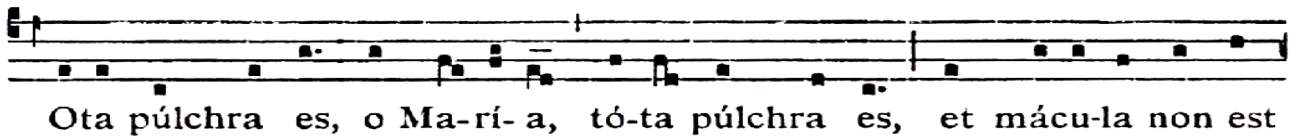
O Virgin Immaculate, * who was pleasing in
