GENERAL REMARKS ON INDULGENCES

From the Office of the Apostolic Penitentiary

An indulgence is defined in the Code of Canon Law (can. 992) and in the Catechism of the Catholic Church (n. 1471) as "a remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven, which the faithful Christian who is duly disposed gains under certain prescribed conditions through the action of the Church which, as the minister of redemption, dispenses and applies with authority the treasury of the satisfactions of Christ and the saints."

In general, the gaining of indulgences requires certain prescribed conditions, and the performance of certain prescribed works.

To gain indulgences, whether plenary or partial, it is necessary that the faithful be in the state of grace at least at the time the indulgenced work is completed.

A plenary indulgence can be gained only once a day. In order to obtain it, the faithful must, in addition to being in the state of grace:

- have the interior disposition of complete detachment from sin, even venial sin;
 - have sacramentally confessed their sins;
 - receive Holy Communion;
 - pray for the intentions of the Supreme Pontiff.

It is appropriate, but not necessary, that the sacramental Confession and especially Holy Communion and the prayer for the Pope's intentions take place on the same day that the indulgenced work is performed; but it is sufficient that these sacred rites and prayers be carried out within several days (about 20) before or after the indulgenced act. One sacramental Confession suffices for several plenary indulgences, but a separate Holy Communion and a separate prayer for the Holy Father's intentions are required for each plenary indulgence. Prayer for the Pope's intentions is left to the choice of the faithful, but an "Our Father" and a "Hail Mary" are suggested. The Pope's intentions are four in number: 1. The progress of the Faith and triumph of the Church; 2. Peace and union among Christian Princes and Rulers; 3. The conversion of sinners; 4. The uprooting of heresy. Indulgences can always be applied either to oneself or to the souls of the deceased, but they cannot be applied to other persons still living.
