ALL SOULS INDULGENCE

he month of November is dedicated to the Holy Souls. On all days <u>from November 1 through November 8</u> <u>inclusive</u>, a plenary indulgence*, applicable only to the Poor Souls, is granted to those who visit a cemetery and pray, even if only mentally, for the departed. Partial indulgences are granted to those who recite Lauds or Vespers of the Office of the Dead, as well as to those who recite the prayer:

"Requiem aeternam dona eis, Domini, et lux perpetua luceat eis. Requiescant in pace."

(Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord, and let the perpetual light shine upon them. May they rest in peace.)

* Plenary, under the usual conditions. -Partial Indulgence when fervently recited.

SOLEMNITY OF CHRIST THE KING

In 1925, Pope Pius XI instituted the Feast of Christ the King as a solemn affirmation of Our Lord's Kingship over every human society. This Feast is to be celebrated on the last Sunday of October. In his Encyclical Letter *Quas primas* the pope explicates that Christ is the King of Families, Peoples and Countries and even the whole universe. Our Lord, however, wishes also to be the King of our souls. This Solemnity has also a very special signification to the Institute of Christ the King Sovereign Priest; it is this title of Christ as King and Sovereign Priest which the Institute has chosen as both its name and program.

TO RESTORE ALL THINGS IN CHRIST

By decree of the Apostolic Penitentiary a plenary indulgence may be gained under the usual conditions by all who assist at Mass on this feast day in a church of the Institute of Christ the King.

After the 11:00 AM Solemn Mass, we will continue the solemnities with a reception in honor of Christ the King in Fr. Wickens Hall. All are welcome.

rayer. Almighty and eternal God, Who hast wished to restore all things through Thy beloved Son, the King of the universe, graciously grant that all the families of the Gentiles separated by the wound of sin, may be subjected to His most loving dominion, Who with Thee liveth.

pistle. Col. 1, 12-20. Brethren, we give thanks to God the Father, Who hath made us worthy to be partakers of the lot of the saints in light: Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the kingdom of the Son of His love. In Whom we have redemption through His blood, the remission of sins; Who is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of every creature; for in Him were all things created in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones, or dominations, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by Him and in Him. And He is before all, and by Him all things consist. If My kingdom were of this world, My servants would certainly strive that I should not be delivered to the Jews: but now My kingdom is not from hence. Pilate therefore said to him: Art thou a king then? Jesus answered: Thou sayest that I am a King. For this was I born, and for this came I into the world; that I should give testimony to the truth, Everyone that is of the truth, heareth My voice.
