## PRAYERS & INSTRUCTION

### THE BLESSINGS WE OWE TO THE THREE PERSONS

The mystery of the Holy Trinity is the greatest of all mysteries. The feast which the Church has appointed to be celebrated on this day in Its honor is, as it were, the complement and gathering up into one of all the feasts of the ecclesiastical year.

The blessed Trinity is a mystery quite beyond our comprehension, the finite being incapable of understanding the infinite; but we must adore It with the deepest humility, the most tender love, and the liveliest gratitude, for It is the source of all good to us. In order to excite these sentiments, let us call to mind all that we owe to the love of the Three Persons of the Most Holy Trinity.

"I believe in God the Father Almighty, Creator of heaven and earth." Omnipotence, and the work of creation, which implies omnipotence, is the spe-

cial attribute of the Father, because He is the first principal from which the two other Persons proceed. To Him, then, I owe my existence, my preservation, and all that has conduced to my preservation; without Him I should be nothing and should always have remained nothing.

God saw from all eternity, in the nothingness out of which you were created, millions of possible beings, who would have served Him better than you have done, and glorified Him more; why, then, has He created you rather than them? Out of a gratuitous love of predilection: "I have loved thee with an everlasting love." To this love you owe it that you have been preserved from so many dangers in which others have perished, and that you enjoy so many peculiar favors both of nature and grace.

My friends, love demands love in return. What return have you made to so loving and generous a God and Father? Perhaps you have loved Him but little and served Him grudgingly.

*Love and benefits of God the Son*

The love of God the Son for us has been manifested in a still more striking manner than by the benefit of creation, namely, by that of redemption, which has not only ransomed us from slavery and death but reinstated us in all our primitive rights. What would be thought in the world if the son of a king should take the place of a criminal, and offer his life for him?

This is what the Son of God has done for each one of us. "*He debased Himself;*" says the Apostle, "*taking the form of a servant, becoming obedient unto death, even the death of the cross.*"

# TRINITY SUNDAY



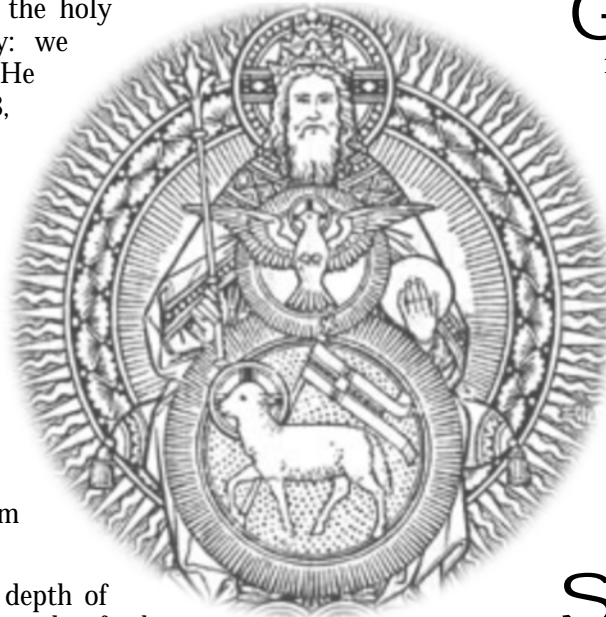
**I**ntroit. Tob. 12, 6. Blessed be the holy Trinity, and undivided Unity: we will give glory to Him, because He hath shown His mercy to us. Ps. 8, 2. O Lord our Lord, how wonderful is Thy name in all the earth. V. Glory.

**P**rayer. Almighty, eternal God, by Whose gift Thy servants, in the confession of the true faith, acknowledge the glory of the eternal Trinity, and adore the Unity in the power of His majesty, we beseech Thee that in the firmness of the same faith we may ever be defended from all adversities. Through our Lord.

**E**pistle. Rom. 11, 33-36. O the depth of the riches of the wisdom and of the knowledge of God! How incomprehensible are His judgments, and how unsearchable His ways! For who hath known the mind of the Lord? Or who hath been His counsellor? Or who hath first given to Him, and recompense shall be made Him? For of Him, and by Him, and in Him, are all things: to Him be glory for ever. Amen.

**G**radual. Dan. 3, 55, 56. Blessed art Thou, O Lord, Who beholdest the depths, and sittest upon the cherubim. V. Blessed art Thou, O Lord, in the firmament of heaven, and worthy of praise for ever.

**A**lleluia, alleluia, V. Blessed art Thou, O Lord God of our fathers, and worthy of praise for ever. Alleluia.



**G**ospel. Matt. 28, 18-20. At that time, Jesus said to His disciples, All power is given to Me in heaven and in earth. Going, therefore, teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost. Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you; and behold I am with you all days, even to the consummation of the world.

**O**ffertory. Tob. 12, 6. Blessed be God the Father, and the only-begotten Son of God, and also the Holy Spirit; because He hath shown His mercy toward us.

**S**ecret. By the invocation of Thy holy name, O Lord, our God, sanctify, we beseech Thee, the matter of this oblation, and through it make us ourselves a perfect offering forever. Through our Lord.

**C**ommunion. Tob. 12, 6. We bless the God of heaven, and before all living we will praise Him; because He has shown His mercy to us.

**P**ostcommunion. May the receiving of this sacrament, O Lord, our God, and the confession of our faith in the eternal, holy Trinity and undivided Unity, profit us for the health of body and soul. Through our Lord.

From which the Apostle concludes that we ought henceforth to live only for Him who died for us: *"That they also who live may not now live to themselves, but unto Him who died for them."* Have we given this proof of our love and gratitude to Him?

### *Love and benefits of the Holy Ghost*

The love of the Holy Ghost manifests itself especially in our sanctification and adoption. He sanctified us in our Baptism, purifying our soul from all stain, filling it with divine charity, and all those prerogatives of sanctifying grace which raise us to the dignity of adopted sons and heirs of God, and co-heirs of Jesus Christ. In the words of St Paul, *"The charity of God is poured forth in our hearts by the Holy Ghost, who is*

*given to us."* For the *"Spirit Himself giveth testimony to our spirit that we are the sons of God; and if sons, heirs also, heirs indeed of God and joint-heirs with Christ."* The Holy Ghost has also sanctified us in our Confirmation, and in partaking of the other Sacraments; and still further by the attractions of His grace leading us on toward the perfection of our state of life.

How many benefits have I received, again without any merit on my part, and even in spite of my great unworthiness! "What shall I render to the Lord," to the Three Persons of the Blessed Trinity, "for all the things that He has given me?"
