TABERNACLE DOORS UPDATE

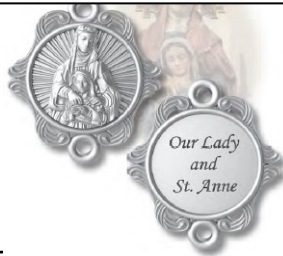
The gold-leaf is on, and the background, vines, and grapes are painted in. The angels will be painted soon. After they have dried over several days, a temporary retouch varnish will be applied so that the doors can be hung. After one year a damar varnish will be applied to protect the images from dust and smoke.

CHURCH FRONT DOORS

The refurbishing of the six front entrance doors, including their frames and transoms located on the North Elevation of the St. Joseph Shrine building continues. This project will also include the refurbishing of the main vestibule inside doors, with the installation of new large windows comprising etched Institute of Christ the King crests, making the main entrance even more welcoming. In that same spirit and following that same perennial tradition, we kindly ask that you do not dialogue with the priest when attending a Low Mass, and that you do not recite or sing the Divine Office or Angelus when recited in Latin by the community.
