Please allow me to take this opportunity to remind you some details regarding Mass Stipends. A priest can offer Mass for an infinite amount of intentions because the merits of the Mass are infinite. A priest can receive only ONE intention with a stipend per Mass.

The **minimum** for a stipend offering is \$10. Please know this is quite low compared to other countries. A stipend is 20 Euro in Europe, for example. If there is true financial incapability of this please see a Canon and of course we will offer the Mass. This reminder is so that the norm remains.




