Children's Catechism = 6-12 yrs old. 2nd & 4th Tuesdays of the month Teenage Catechism = 13-19 yrs old. 1st & 3rd Tuesdays of the month

1st Communion Catechism = starting at age 6, classes began in November, on designated Saturdays Confirmation Catechism = starting at age 10/11, classes began in January, on designated Saturdays




