SUNDAY, MAY 7, 2023 4TH SUNDAY AFTER EASTER (Mass Propers available in the Parish Bulletin)

Dear faithful,

Our Lord tells the Apostles in today's Gospel that he will soon leave them, and that this is the reason for their sorrow (John 16;5-14). It will nevertheless, He goes on, be expedient for them that He should leave them, for otherwise the Holy Spirit will not come to them.

The Holy Spirit is not the only one who will be with them, however. We know that Our Lord has remained with us as well, in His Real Presence. Saint Francis de Sales teaches us that in receiving Holy Communion, we are incorporated into:

"...the perfect Communion of Saints, for it is the food common to angels, and sainted souls in Paradise, and ourselves; it is the true bread of which all Christians participate. The forgiveness of sins, the author of forgiveness being there, is confirmed; the seed of our resurrection sown, life everlasting bestowed. ... This very belief in the most holy Sacrament, which in truth, reality, and substance, contains the true and natural body of Our Lord, is actually the abridgment of our faith, according to that of the Psalmist 'He had made a memory of his wonderful works'".

May we cherish Our Lord therefore in every single Communion we receive during our short lives, and pray that each of these would truly be for us the pledge of eternal life.

The <u>May Crowning and First Communions</u> are this Sunday, May 7 at 12:30 pm. The ceremonies will begin with the procession from the church to Our Lady's statue in the garden, where Our Lady will be solemnly crowned to properly begin the most beautiful of months and that which is dedicated to her. Afterwards, we will process back into the church for the Mass. Please say some extra prayers for these young faithful on the day of this spiritual milestone in their lives!

Next <u>Saturday</u>, <u>May 13 is the anniversary</u> of the first apparition of Our Blessed Mother at <u>Fatima</u>. At the request of Monsignor Wach, Prior General of the Institute, we will honor Our Blessed Mother with a Votive Mass of the Immaculate Heart at 10 am, followed by Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament. The Litany of Loreto will be chanted, and we will recite the Consecration to the Immaculate Heart of Mary.
