SUNDAY, JUNE 11, 2023 EXT. SOLEMNITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI

Dear faithful.

Greetings from Baltimore! Did you know that the Archdiocese of Baltimore is the oldest in the United States, having been founded in 1789? The colony of Maryland was founded by George Calvert, 1st Baron Baltimore, a Catholic convert who sought to provide a religious haven for Catholics persecuted in England.

We celebrate this Sunday the **External Solemnity of Corpus Christi**, the Feast of the Body and Blood of the Lord. There will be the traditional **Eucharistic Procession** after the 12:30 Mass. A more simple reception will be held outside in the garden, rather than in the hall, in light of the extended ceremonies.

One of the questions we might ask ourselves on the Feast of Corpus Christi is: Would we not have already been infinitely blessed if Christ had given us His spiritual presence and sanctifying grace alone? Of course. But He was not content to limit His gift of self in this way. He was not content until He became our real and heavenly food in the adorable Sacrament of the Altar, uniting us to Himself in soul and body. May we always therefore approach this Sacred Banquet with a burning love and gratitude for this Divine Bread and the nourishment of our souls, Our Lord's own Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity.

A big "thank you" to Fr. Donald Morgan for replacing me for both Sunday Masses this weekend, and to Canon Dumain for his help this week. I hope you had a chance to greet him and enjoy His charming French accent.

This <u>Friday</u>, <u>June 16 is the Feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus</u>. The 6 pm Mass will be followed by the usual Adoration, with the chanted Litany of the Sacred Heart and the Act of Reparation to the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

The monthly devotions to <u>Our Mother of Perpetual Help</u> will be this Saturday, June 17 after the 10 am Mass. Booklets will be provided.

We will celebrate the **External Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus** on Sunday, June 18. Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament with the chanted Litany of the Sacred Heart and the Act of Reparation will follow the 12:30 Mass. The reception will again be outside in the garden.

We will also take up our annual collection for the <u>Sisters Adorers</u> next Sunday. Thank you for your generosity towards these sisters who pray for you continually!

<u>Did you Know? Henrietta Maria of France</u>

The State of Maryland owes its namesake to Henrietta Maria of France (November 25, 1609 – September 10, 1669).

She was the Queen of England, Scotland and Ireland from her marriage to King Charles I on June 13, 1625, until he was executed on 30 January 1649. A devout Roman Catholic, her religion heavily influenced Henrietta Maria's time as queen, particularly the early years of her marriage. In July 1626, she caused huge controversy by stopping at Tyburn to pray for Catholics executed there, and later tried to convert her Calvinist nephew Prince Rupert during his stay in England. Henrietta Maria was open about her beliefs, obstructing plans to require the eldest sons of Catholic families to be raised as Protestants, and also facilitated Catholic marriages, a criminal offense under English law at the time.
