SUNDAY, JUNE 18, 2023 EXT. SOL. OF THE SACRED HEART

Dear faithful,

We celebrate this Sunday the External Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Since the Heart of Jesus appears to us as the sensible sign of His love, the visible wound in the Heart will naturally recall the invisible wound of this love. The Heart of Flesh toward which the worship is directed in order to read therein the love of Jesus, is the Heart of Jesus, the real, living Heart that, in all truth, may be said to have loved and suffered; the Heart that, as we feel ourselves, had such a share in His emotional and moral life; the Heart that, as we know from a knowledge, however basic, of the operations of our human life, had such a part in the operations of the Master's life.

Let us note as well that the relation of the Heart to the love of Christ is not that of a purely conventional sign, as in the relation of the word to the thing, or of the flag to the idea of one's country; this Heart has been and is still inseparably connected with that life of benefactions and love. As such, devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus is most eminently suited to stir in our hearts a love which seeks to reciprocate the burning love of this Divine Heart for us poor fallen sinners. May the Heart of Jesus be loved, honored and adored, now and forever!

The Act of Reparation to the Sacred Heart will be recited after both Masses, and there will be **Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament** and the chanted Litany of the Sacred Heart after the 12:30 Mass. There will again be a simple reception in the garden.

Have you heard the news? The Institute of Christ the King gives thanks to Almighty God for the acquisition of a <u>new retreat center</u>, on more than one-hundred acres of sprawling and bucolic Wisconsin countryside. Located in Burlington, Wisconsin, this former Franciscan monastery will be known as <u>Sacred Heart Retreat Center</u> and serve year-round as a primary locale for youth camps, retreats of the Society of the Sacred Heart and others. I hope you appreciated the devotions to <u>Our Mother of Perpetual Help.</u> You are all heartily <u>encouraged to join in</u> the chanting of the opening hymn to Our Lady. As this devotion was held in the past at our Oakland Apostolate and continues at other Institute apostolates, my hope is that it will serve as a column of our apostolate's devotional life.

Our monthly First Saturday and Perpetual Help (Third Saturday) devotions are important pillars of this apostolate's Marian devotion, but we could be honoring Our Lady even more. On the <u>other Saturdays of the month</u>, the Litany of Loreto will be recited after the 10 am Mass. We already have weekly devotions to Saint Joseph, it only makes sense to offer Our Lady at least the same regularity in our devotion.

We will take up our annual collection for the <u>Sisters Adorers</u> this Sunday. Thank you for your generosity towards these sisters who pray for you continually!
