Dear faithful,

We celebrate this weekend the Fourth Sunday after Pentecost. In this Sunday's Gospel, we see Saint Peter and the other disciples take up the work they're called to by Our Lord, and that not at first with great enthusiasm. In *The Liturgical Year*, Dom Guéranger teaches us that one lesson of today's Gospel is that of the reward of obedience, of the success of the work which is undertaken at God's word, and for a right intention. Work which is carried out at God's command is certain of success. To that kind of work belongs every task which is prescribed by one's vocation.

The state of life in which a man finds himself brings its definite tasks and duties. These may be regarded as more or less directly ordered by God, and with God's command to execute such tasks there goes a guarantee that His help will be given for their performance. Let us not therefore dwell on our hardships or on the failures, real or apparent, of the past. We know the work God has called us to. With Him helping us, we can take it up with courage and vigor! As Saint Paul reminds us, it may be man who waters, but it will be God who gives the increase.

Blessing everyone's items can be a time-consuming affair, owing to the number of these requests and the fact that every different kind of holy object, be it an image, a scapular, a Rosary, etc., has its own special rite of blessing in the Roman Ritual. In an effort to make the blessing of these items available to the largest number of individuals possible, and in the most efficient manner possible, these blessings will now be carried out only on <u>the 4th Saturday of each</u> <u>month after the 10 am Mass.</u> All who would like items blessed are asked to observe this schedule. Please bring your items with you on the scheduled day; no item will be accepted for safekeeping in advance of the 4th Saturday. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.

<u>Next Saturday is July 1</u>, First Saturday and the Feast of the Most Precious Blood of Our Lord, a first class feast. Indeed the entire month of July is dedicated to the Precious Blood. Whenever we receive Holy Communion, let us reflect and meditate on the fact that Our Lord was not content until He had shed every last drop of His Blood for our redemption and salvation.
