Dear faithful.

Liturgically, this Fifth Sunday after Pentecost is quite eventful. We begin the month of July, the Month of the Precious Blood of Our Lord, and we also commemorate the Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary to Saint Elizabeth (July 2). Our Lady being the true mother of Our Lord, it is she who gave Him His human nature, and thus His Blood. Our dear Lord now gives us His Blood to drink every time we receive Him in the Holy Eucharist. He is wholly, entirely and really present, in the chalice and the consecrated hosts, in the adorable Sacrament of the Altar. The *Catholic Encyclopedia* (1907) teaches us this regarding Our Savior's Blood:

"Jesus, at the Last Supper, ascribes to it the same life-giving power that belongs to His flesh (see EUCHARIST). The Apostles, St. Peter (1 Peter 1:2, 19), St. John (1 John 1:7; Apocalypse 1:5 etc.), and above all St. Paul (Romans 3:25; Ephesians 1:7; Hebrews 9:10) regard it as synonymous with Jesus's Passion and Death, the source of redemption. The Precious Blood is therefore a part of the Sacred Humanity and hypostatically united to the Second Person of the Blessed Trinity..."

We are pleased to announce a momentous upcoming event: the First Solemn Mass of Canon Jacob Wells, originally from our humble Oakland Apostolate. The Mass will be at 12:30 pm on Sunday, July 16. Also joining us will be the U.S. Provincial Superior of the Institute, Canon Matthew Talarico, and our very own Abbé Cody Teague, who recently received the clerical cassock and tonsure! Deo gratias!

The faithful who attend the First Mass of a newly ordained priest have traditionally been granted a plenary indulgence, under the usual conditions, throughout Church history. The **First Blessing** of a newly ordained priest, which Canon Wells will give immediately following the Mass, also carries with it special graces.
