Dear Faithful,

It has been a delight for me to serve this last week the Oakland Apostolate of the Institute of Christ the King Sovereign Priest (ICKSP) at St. Margaret Mary Catholic Church. I am a priest of the diocese of Marquette, MI. It is a great grace for me to be in formation to become a Canon with the ICKSP. I have been serving at St. Francis de Sales Oratory in St. Louis for two years. I love the Traditional Latin Mass (TLM.) When I was in seminary, I went to my first TLM and knew this was the Mass I was called to celebrate. The beauty of the prayers, the incense, the Gregorian chant, the Communion rail, the facing East, only men serving in the sanctuary, the Latin, the use of the Vulgate, consecrated fingers and reverence for Our Eucharistic King are just some of the reasons why we are so blessed to be Catholic, a liturgy given to us by the Apostles. REMINDERS:

Blessing of Sacramentals on the 4th Saturday of each month

The Blessing of Sacramentals will take place next Saturday, August 26 after the 10 am Mass, by Canon Zignego. Please place your various sacramentals (rosaries, medals, scapulars, statues, images, oil and salt) on the benches in front of the front pews before the 10 am Mass. To make the blessings as efficient as possible, please make sure that it is easy to see your sacramentals for what they are (rosaries, for example) from a few feet away. If your sacramentals are small or covered (plastic wrapping, cloth sack, etc.), please clearly label them for what they are, in large letters. If you have multiple kinds of sacramentals (e.g., rosaries, scapulars, medals), it is recommended to put them in a container, such as a bag or box. The container must be clearly labeled to indicate what is inside. It is also recommended to put your name on all labels.
