Dear faithful,

In the commentary of *The Liturgical Year* for this Fifteenth Sunday after Pentecost, Dom Prosper Guéranger has a very striking analogy to illustrate the folly of vainglory:

"Just let us think, for a moment, on the madness *that* culprit would be guilty of who, having his sentence to death commuted for a severe flogging, should take pride in the stripes left on his body by the whip! May this madness never be ours!"

Dom Guéranger is speaking here of the proper attitude with regards to bodily mortifications, a timely subject indeed at the end of the summer season. Remember: our fasting and penance is the fruit of God's grace working in us, not the product of our own strength. Moreover, the best penances are those we do not choose – the crosses God has prepared for us. As Saint Paul reminds us in today's epistle that each one "shall bear his own burden," we do well to recall the central place which the Cross has in uniting us with the suffering Christ in this life. He who suffers well here below merits an everlasting crown in the world to come, and unending joy!

September, as you know, is the month of the <u>Holy Cross</u>, and the very ancient and beloved Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross is this <u>Thursday</u>, <u>September 14</u>. There will also be the ancient <u>weather blessing</u> with the relic of the True Cross after the 12 pm Mass this Thursday. Given the rain inundations earlier this year, I think you can understand the importance of this blessing! A ball of hail might not go through your windshield...an earthquake could be averted...a wildfire might never spark...we live in California, after all.

It is time to start thinking about preparation for the <u>Sacrament of Confirmation</u>. Tentatively planned for November of 2024, it is never too early to start getting all the necessary paperwork together (notably, sacramental certificates). Please contact me as soon as possible if you would like to add your children to the list of those to be confirmed next year.

Those who would prepare for Confirmation must attend the <u>Confirmation Catechism class</u>! After a two-month pause, the weekly Catechism Classes restart this week. Confirmation Catechism will be this Tuesday at 4 pm, and Adult Catechism will be next Saturday at 2:30 pm. There is a <u>new Zoom link</u> for the classes. Last year's link will not work, so please contact me if you need the new one.

As we begin a new academic year, it is also a propitious moment to bring a bit of new life to the various facets of this apostolate, one of the most important being the <u>Altar Server Corps</u>. Please consider allowing your sons the privilege of serving the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. All the saints agree that this is the greatest opportunity a young man can enjoy on this side of eternity! The <u>altar server training</u> which had been scheduled for this Saturday had to be postponed due to a conflict with the parish schedule. The server training has been rescheduled for Saturday, September 30 at 11:30 am.
