# SUNDAY, DECEMBER 31, 2023 SUNDAY IN THE OCTAVE OF CHRISTMAS

Dear faithful,

On this last day of the year of Our Lord 2023, I would like you all to know that I will be praying for a blessed and fruitful new year for each of you. May the Holy Triune God continue to guide us in the ways of His holiness through both prosperity and adversity, and may we remember that everything, even the most unpleasant experiences, works unto the good for those who love God.

<u>This Sunday</u> after the 12:30 Mass, there will be a <u>Solemn Te Deum</u> and <u>Benediction</u> of the Blessed Sacrament, in thanksgiving for all the graces received during the last year. This <u>Monday</u>, <u>January 1</u>, the <u>Veni Creator</u> will be chanted before the 12:30 Mass to implore God's graces for the new year. For each of these, a <u>plenary indulgence</u> is available under the usual conditions when one is present for all of the ceremonies. Exceptionally, there will <u>not be a 6 pm Mass</u> <u>this Monday</u>.

<u>He's back!</u> <u>Abbé Cody Teague</u>, now in his second year at St. Philip Neri Seminary ("Gricigliano"), the International Seminary of the Institute of Christ the King located outside Florence, Italy, has returned to us for several days of Christmas vacation. Abbé Teague, as you know, is not our only Institute seminarian from the Oakland Apostolate. <u>Abbé Alex Hoopes</u>, now in his fourth year of seminary, will be joining us next Sunday, January 7. Please be sure to greet them both, and of course to pray for these dedicated young seminarians.

Saturday, January 6 is the Feast of the <u>Epiphany of Our Lord</u>, a Feast of the First Class and one of the most ancient and solemn feasts of the entire Liturgical Year. There will be the <u>traditional blessings</u> of gold, frankincense, myrrh and chalk after the First Saturday devotions.

The annual <u>Walk for Life West Coast</u> will take place on Saturday, January 20 in San Francisco. The event will begin at 11 am. As always, the Oakland and San Jose Apostolates of the Institute of Christ the King will take part in this important occasion of witness to the sanctity of human life, particularly the unborn threatened with abortion.
