Dear faithful,

The <u>Pre-Lenten season</u> has arrived! This Sunday, January 28 begins the liturgical time known as <u>Septuagesima</u>. Violet vestments return to the altar for Sunday Mass, along with the suppression of the Gloria and the use of relics. The Alleluia is replaced by the more penitential Tract. The organ and flowers will still be present, however, until Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, February 14.

Would you like a practical recommendation for your interior life? Now that Septuagesima has begun, it is a good idea to decide upon and begin keeping already one's Lenten resolution. Let us prepare our Lent assiduously in this way, and not procrastinate. This will help us respond to God's graceful promptings with greater quickness, fervor and fidelity during the liturgical year's most penitential season, which begins in just a little over two weeks.

Thank you for your prayers while I was away on vacation! I had a restful time indeed, and I'm glad to be back in Oakland with you all. It was good to get back to Tucson, where I first discovered the Traditional Latin Mass through St. Gianna Latin Mass Community, now St. Gianna Oratory, an apostolate of the Institute.

Have you already turned in your <u>blessed palms</u> from last Palm Sunday? If not, please deposit them in the wicker baskets in the vestibule at your earliest convenience. The palms must be burned to make the ashes which will be blessed on Ash Wednesday.

This Monday, January 29 is the <u>Feast of St. Francis de Sales</u>, one of the principal Patrons of our dear institute, and thus a first-class feast for all Institute apostolates. A plenary indulgence is available under the usual conditions

There are still a few days left to <u>donate diapers and baby wipes</u> downstairs in Fr. Kozina Hall. The Feast of the Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary, <u>Candlemas</u>, is this <u>Friday</u>, <u>February 2</u>. There will be the Blessing of Candles and Procession at 6 pm, followed by a Low Mass with organ and First Friday devotions. Please be sure to <u>bring your own candles</u> for the blessing. February 2 is also the traditional day for taking down one's <u>Christmas creche</u> and decorations.

<u>Candles of pure beeswax</u> (100%) will be available after the 7 am and 12:30 pm Masses this Sunday. The suggested donation is \$30 per candle (3"x6" pillar candles.) All profits will go to the Building Fund for the San Jose Apostolate of the Institute of Christ the King.

The <u>Blessing of Throats</u> for the Commemoration of Saint Blaise will be on Saturday, February 3 after the 10 am Mass.
