SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 4, 2024 SEXAGESIMA SUNDAY (Mass Propers available in the Parish Bulletin)

Dear faithful,

It is Our Lord's parable of the sower and the seed which fell upon four different sorts of ground which Holy Mother Church puts before our eyes on this Sexagesima Sunday. The Word of God can be heard by the ears of many, but sadly, a great number will not let it permeate and change their hearts for the better, because of the temptations, cares and distractions of this life. But there is hope – the hope that the "good ground" will be found in our souls:

"But that on the good ground, are they who in a good and perfect heart, hearing the word, keep it, and bring forth fruit in patience" (Luke 8;4-15).

How do we know that the Word of God has truly fallen upon the "good ground" of a heart that seeks His good pleasure above all else? We should never be too quick to assume that we fall into this category. A heart which spurns presumption and trusts not in its own merits, but rather in the infinite mercy and power of God, is the surest sign that the seed is growing fruitfully in our souls.

Again, a <u>big "Thank you"</u> for all your generous support of the Oakland Apostolate and indeed the entire U.S. Province of the Institute throughout the last year. On <u>Sunday, February 18</u>, the Institute launches its annual <u>Provincial Appeal</u>. Last year, the province-wide collection raised <u>over \$152,000</u>! With Candlemas (February 2) comes the change of the seasonal Marian antiphon to the hopeful and lovely *Ave Regina Caelorum*. Copies are available in church and Flocknote.

Our gratitude goes out to Thomas and Diana Henriksson for continuing a venerable tradition here at St. Margaret Mary's: <u>Lenten Prayer Cards for Seminari-</u> <u>ans.</u> Prayer cards will be distributed in the vestibule after the 7 am and 12:30 pm Masses this Sunday. Your prayers are so important for these young men. It is requested to recite one decade of the Rosary each day (or even 5 decades, for those who are able) for the seminarian on your card.

It's time to burn last year's <u>**Palm Sunday palms**</u> to prepare for Ash Wednesday, February 14. Please place your palms in the basket in the vestibule. Thank you!

Quinquagesima Sunday, the last Sunday before the beginning of Lent, is next Sunday, February 11. We will have a <u>"Forty Hours" devotion</u> by having a Holy Hour of Adoration following the 12:30 Mass. There will also be a Holy Hour after the 6 pm Masses on Monday, February 12 and Tuesday, February 13.

To enroll your children in the <u>First Communion class</u>, please contact Canon at: <u>canon.norman@institute-christ-king.org</u>. The once weekly Zoom class begins Wednesday, February 28 at 4 pm and First Communions will be in early May.

There is one group of volunteers that, in my opinion, I do not thank often enough. That would be the <u>Corps of Altar Servers</u>. These young men put in weekly hours of training and serving, applying their energies and disciplining themselves, in order to give glory to God in the Holy Mass. While we have a respectable number of servers, it never hurts to add to the ranks.

Moreover, joining the Corps of Altar Servers provides those who serve often, spending a considerable length of time on their knees, to profit from the help of others by vesting and sitting in choir in the sanctuary for Mass, thus enjoying a more meditative assistance at the Mass and getting some needed rest for the body.
