Dear faithful,

Only a few days ago, ashes were placed in the form of a cross on our foreheads, and we were solemnly reminded of the inevitable day on which we will leave behind this world and go before God for judgement. May we live forever in a manner conducive to a happy meeting on that all-important day.

And now, let us look at the divine object that is before us. It is our Emmanuel; the same Jesus, but not under the form of the sweet Babe whom we adored in his Crib. He is grown to the fullness of the age of man, and wears the semblance of a Sinner, trembling and humbling himself before the Sovereign Majesty of his Father, whom we have offended, and to whom he now offers himself as the Victim of propitiation. He loves us with a Brother's love; and seeing that the season for our doing penance has begun, he comes to cheer us on by his presence and his own example.

We are going to spend Forty Days in earnest penance for our sins. Our Lord, who is innocence itself, goes through the same penance. We have separated ourselves, for a time, from the pleasures and vanities of the world. Christ withdraws from the company and sight of men. We intend to assist at the Divine Services more assiduously, and pray more fervently, than at other times: Jesus spends forty days and forty nights in prayer, like the humblest suppliant, and all this for us. We are going to think over our past sins and bewail them in bitter grief. The Lord made man suffers for them and weeps over them in the silence of the desert, as though He himself had committed them.
