Rogation Procession & Mass

The Minor Rogation Days occur on the three days preceding the feast of the Ascension. They are days of prayer, and traditionally also of abstinence, instituted by the Church to appease God's anger at man's transgressions, to ask the Lord for protection in calamities, and for the blessing of a good and bountiful harvest.

The order to be observed in the procession comes from the Roman Ritual, one of the six principal liturgical books of the Roman Rite. In summary, the prayers consist of: the antiphon "Exsurge Domine" ("Arise, O Lord"), the Litany of the Saints (chanted with each verse and response repeated), Psalm 69 "Deus in adiutorium" ("Lord, come to my assistance"), versicles and responses, and several collects. If the procession is held, it is followed by the Rogation Mass (both of which take place in violet).

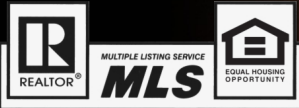
