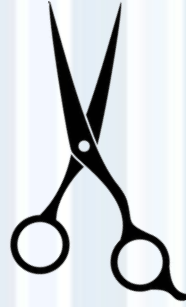

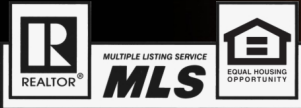

WRITTEN BY ST. THOMAS AQUINAS
