*'A partial indulgence is granted the Christian faithful who recite the hymn **Te Deum** as an act of thanksgiving. The indulgence will be a **plenary** one if this hymn is publicly recited on the last day of the year.'*

*'A partial indulgence is granted the Christian faithful who devoutly recite the hymn **Veni, Creator**. The indulgence will be a **plenary** one when this hymn is publicly recited on the first day of January.'*

(These indulgences are gained under the usual conditions)

***Directives concerning the
Blessing of Epiphany Water & Chalk***

Please bring an EMPTY container to collect Epiphany water. The water to be blessed is furnished by the Oratory. The Epiphany water will afterwards be available in the Holy Water Font for the faithful who wish to fill their holy water containers.

Chalk to be blessed is provided by the Oratory. If you do not already have blessed chalk, you may take a chunk of chalk home for the Epiphany House Blessing. Please keep your blessed chalk for next year. **Registered Members who signed up for Epiphany home blessing by the Canons do not need to take chalk as the Canons will bring their own blessed chalk.**

- ◆ Receive Holy Communion,
- ◆ Say five decades of the Rosary, and
- ◆ Keep me company for a quarter of an hour, meditating on the 15 mysteries of the Rosary.'

1. Blasphemies against the Immaculate Conception of Mary.

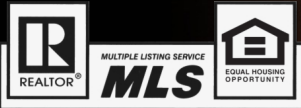

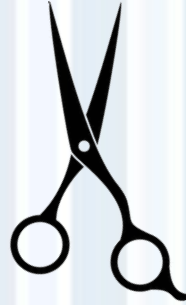

HYMN OF THANKSGIVING: TE DEUM LAUDAMUS

We praise Thee, O God: we acknowledge Thee to be the Lord. All the earth doth worship Thee: the Father everlasting. To Thee all Angels cry aloud: the heavens and all the Powers therein. To Thee the Cherubim and Seraphim cry with unceasing voice: Holy, Holy, Holy: Lord God of Hosts. Heaven and earth are full of the majesty of



Thy glory. The glorious choir of the Apostles, The admirable company of the Prophets, The white-robed army of Martyrs praise Thee The Holy Church throughout all the world doth acknowledge Thee, The Father of infinite Majesty, Thine adorable, true and only Son, Also the Holy Ghost the Paraclete. Thou art the King of Glory, O Christ. Thou art the everlasting Son of the Father. Thou having taken upon Thee to deliver man didst not abhor the Virgin's womb. Thou having overcome the sting of death didst open to believers the kingdom of heaven. Thou sittest at the right hand of God in the glory of the Father. We believe that Thou shalt come to be our Judge.

(Kneeling) We beseech Thee, therefore, help Thy servants: whom Thou has redeemed with Thy precious Blood.

Make them to be numbered with Thy Saints in glory everlasting. Lord, save Thy people: and bless Thine inheritance. Govern them and lift them up forever. Day by day we bless Thee. And we praise Thy name forever: and world without end. Vouchsafe, O Lord, this day to keep us without sin. Have mercy on us, O Lord: have mercy on us. Let Thy mercy, O Lord, be upon us: as we have hoped in Thee. O Lord, in Thee have I hoped: let me not be confounded forever.

Veni Creator Spiritus

Before the Mass on New Year's Day, the priest intones the Veni Creator Spiritus in order to obtain from God blessings for the new year. All the faithful who assist on this day at this chant may obtain a plenary indulgence under the usual conditions. Please kneel for the first verse.
