Infant King Co-Op Policies

Rules to be understood and signed by the Student:

- Tardy Policy- In an effort to cut down on tardiness, students with 6 or more unexcused tardies or absences will be suspended from the class. An email will alert parents after each tardy. Canons will provide intervention after 3 unexcused tardies or absences.
- Rules of courtesy and politeness are required for every class.
- To ask a question: Students are asked to raise their hand, to wait for the teacher to allow them to speak, to stand up and then to ask their question.
- All assignments should be done on time.
- For failed test, student will be asked to redo the test as soon as possible.
- Always use the bathroom at break and lunchtime. No use of the bathroom during classes or Masses.
- No eating in class. (No gum)
- Teachers keep for themselves the right to ask a student to rewrite tests, notes or assignments for unacceptable handwriting.
- Bring required materials every time: Unless you have been instructed otherwise, come to class prepared with all of the required materials you were advised to bring at the beginning of the school year. Do not interrupt the teacher or other students to ask to borrow items you forgot to bring to class.
- Make up Missed Work: If a student has missed a lesson or an assignment, he is required to make arrangements with his teacher to complete the work.
