INTROIT

The Spirit of the Lord fills the world, alleluia, is all-embracing, and knows man's utterance, alleluia, alleluia, alleluia. God arises; His enemies are scattered, and those who hate Him flee before Him.

COLLECT

O God, Who on this day by the light of the Holy Spirit, did teach the hearts of the faithful, grant us by that same Holy Spirit, to know what is right and ever to join in His help.

EPISTLE

Acts 2:1-11

When the days of Pentecost were drawing to a close, they were all together in one place. And suddenly there came a sound from heaven, as of a violent wind blowing, and it filled the whole house where they were sitting. And there appeared to them parted tongues of fire, which settled upon each of them. And they were all filled with the Holy spirit and began to speak in foreign tongues, even as the Holy Spirit prompted them to speak. Now there were staying at Jerusalem, devout Jews, from every nation under heaven, and when this sound was heard, the multitude gathered and were bewildered in mind, because

each heard them speaking in his own language. But they were all amazed and marveled saying, "Behold, are not all these that are speaking Galileans? And how have we heard each his own language in which he was born?
