COMMENTARY ON TODAY'S EPISTLE

Let us also understand the importance and the necessity of mutual union for all Christians. There must be among them that love of the brotherhood which is so frequently and so strongly recommended by the apostles, the cooperators of the Spirit in the building up of the Church. The keeping aloof from schism and heresy, of whose terrible consequences we were told in last Sunday's Gospel; the repression of hatred and jealousy; no, these are not enough to make us become useful members of the Church of Christ. We must, moreover, have a charity which is effective, devoted, persevering, and brings all souls and hearts into true union and harmony; a charity, which, to be worthy of the name, must be warmhearted and generous, for it must make us see God in our fellow men, and that will bring us to look upon their happiness and misfortunes as though they were our own. We must have none of that phlegmatic egotism which finds satisfaction in never putting itself out of the way for anybody. Hateful as such a temperament is, it is far from being a rare one. It holds this peculiar view about charity, that the best way of observing it is to have a complete indifference for those who live with us! Souls of this stamp are not bedding in the divine cement . . . the heavenly builder is compelled to reject them as unfit.
