FROM OUR PASTOR, REV. CANON COMMINS

Three Sundays commemorating three major events of the History of human kind, the history of our fall and redemption; Septuagesima: we meditate on the fall of man with the reading of the promise made to Adam, his disobedience and his fall and exclusion for the garden of Eden. Sexagesima Sunday, 60 days before Easter, the reality of a chastisement because of man's transgression is presented to our attention once again in the episode of the Deluge. The Just Man, Noah receives God's protection despite the waters of purification, and through him the human race receives a savior, but a sacrifice is needed, already prefigured in the Sacrifice of Isaac which we will commemorate on the third Sunday before Lent, known as Quinquagesima Sunday, 50 days before Easter.
