In the early days of the Church, the Pentecost Vigil was one of the times chosen by the Fathers to proceed with the baptisms of catechumens, like the Easter Vigil. Its form therefore follows that of the Easter Vigil, including a first catechetical part. The six prophecies of this first part are indeed part of the ancient baptismal catechesis given to neophytes.

**First Communion and Confirmation:** Children must attend the sacramental catechism classes at the Shrine.

**Holy Matrimony:** Couples planning to marry at the Shrine must call the Rectory for the proper instructions.
