BL. ALFREDO ILDEFONSO CARDINAL SCHUSTER ON THE FEAST OF PENTECOST

The Eleven [Apostles] had prepared for [Pentecost] by their ten-day retreat in the company and under the auspices of the Blessed Virgin.
