Dear parishioners, it's never too early to start thinking about Oktoberfest! Save the date, Sept. 21 and 22. There are many new exciting developments for Oktoberfest this year, many opportunities for everyone to get involved.

Here are three of the changes coming this year

1: We will be developing a commemorative T shirt this year by kicking it off a logo design contest. We want everyone to submit their designs by August 3. All designs will be on display on the social hall for the week of August 4-10 during which time you can vote for your favorite. The winner will be announced August 11. This will be a one color, transparent logo for screen printing on our commemorative t shirt. Get those artistic juices flowing now! Details to come soon!

2: We will be holding our Oktoberfest raffle again this year. As a way for all of you to participate, we are asking that each family pick up a packet of 10 tickets which you can either sell or purchase yourself.
