### PORTIUNCULA Plenary Indulgence

*from the Afternoon of August 1st until August 2nd at Midnight*

The "Portiuncula" was the site of a church found in great disrepair by Saint Francis of Assisi. Our Lord Jesus Christ commanded the saint to rebuild this small church, just as he and his spiritual sons would contribute to the greater renewal of the whole Church.

In a vision to Saint Francis, Our Lord encouraged the saint, after the latter's request, to petition His Vicar, Pope Honorius III, for the grant of a Plenary Indulgence to pilgrims who would make a devout visit to the church of the "Portiuncula".

The Plenary Indulgence has since been extended to all parish churches (such as Saint Joseph's Shrine). It is gained by the devout recitation of an Our Father and the Apostles' Creed in a parish church at any time from the afternoon of August 1st until the end of August 2nd, in addition to the other usual conditions. It may be applied either to oneself or to the faithful departed. As we pray for a similar renewal of the whole Church in our day, let us take advantage of what tradition has christened the, "Pardon of Assisi".
