An ex voto is a visible offering made to Our Lord or one of His saints as a sign that commemorates the grace received. It often takes the form of a sacred image or painting and very often of a heart (as is seen on the wall next to Saint Joseph's Altar), placed in a devotional area next to a sanctuary or next to a publicly venerated image or statue. At Saint Joseph Shrine, our own faithful have participated in the ancient tradition of offering an ex voto to Saint Joseph, in particular, with new devotionals to Our Lady soon to be added.
