## Pentecost and its Octave

The gift of the Holy Spirit in Messianic times was foretold by the prophets; the sending of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles is the beginning of this new era. The Church is founded and Christ's Holy Spirit given to her to "renew the face of the Earth."

The account in the Acts of the Apostles recalls the events of the day of Pentecost; the descent of the Holy Spirit on the Apostles, and the phenomena accompanying it, especially the miracle of tongues, a symbol of the Apostles' universal mission. All nations are called to hear the proclamation of the Good News.

With this presence of the Holy Spirit inspiring and directing the Church in her mission to preach the gospel to the ends of the earth, there goes hand in hand a more intimate and personal presence making new men out of the disciples, who are transformed in their very being. The Sequence of the Mass and the Hymn at Vespers describe and invoke this penetrating action of the Holy Spirit on the hearts of the faithful.

During the entire octave, the reading of the Acts of the Apostles shows this double action of the Holy Spirit in the Church and in the soul of the believer.
