Today we celebrate our constant profession of belief in the doctrine of the Holy Trinity, the most fundamental of Christian truths and most mysterious of all dogmas.

God the Father created us through the Son. God the Son redeemed us and revealed us more fully to ourselves.

God the Holy Ghost sanctifies us in our Holy Church.

Today, on Trinity Sunday, having received the revelation of the Father through the mysteries of Advent and Christmastide; having received the revelation of the Son through the mysteries of Lent, Passiontide, and Easter; and having received the revelation of the Holy Ghost in the storm of glory that broke over Jerusalem on the Fiftieth Day at the Third Hour, the Bride of Christ, the Church, is caught

up in wonder. Mother Church, (and all of us with her, for we are her children, and her prayer is ours) breaks into cries of jubilation, praise, and thanksgiving to the adorable and undivided Trinity: Father, Son and Holy Ghost.


Monsignor Wach Visit Sunday, June 16


