
## COME, FOR ALL IS NOW READY

## Month of the Sacred Heart of Jesus Devotion of the Month

Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus is one of the most popular Catholic devotions. Although it was beloved in previous centuries, Jesus appeared to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque in 1673, showing her a vision of the now-famous image of His Sacred Heart, surrounded by flames. He said to her: "My Heart is so full of love for men that It can no longer contain the flames of Its burning love. I must discover to men the treasures of My Heart and save them from perdition." She was given the special mission to spread devotion to His Sacred Heart throughout the Church. Jesus gave St. Margaret Mary many promises associated with this devotion, and requested that a feast day in honor of His

Sacred Heart be instituted on the Friday after the Octave of Corpus Christi. In 1856, the Feast of the Sacred Heart was spread to the Universal Church, and in 1899 Pope Leo XIII solemnly consecrated all mankind to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, calling it "the great act" of his pontificate.





## ST. PATRICK'S ORATORY PHOTO DIRECTORY



Canon Boucheron would like an updated St. Patrick's Oratory Photo Directory to be created, especially with all the new individuals and families at St. Patrick's Oratory since our last photo directory was done in 2021! In this directory, we will include the restoration projects of our beautiful church. Many Oratory groups and activities will also be displayed. Canon would like all registered members to be a part of this Photo Directory. It is a great way to recognize those you see in church and help everyone feel part of our church family.

We will be creating and printing our Photo Directory this year. Beth Relyea Photography (Oratory Member) has been hired to take the individual/family photos. This will allow us to be more flexible in days and times for Photo Sessions. Oratory members can expect a lower cost for the Photo Directory (which would be \$15) and less expensive photo options (see below).

When will photos be taken?	July 7-10, July 12-14
Where will photos be taken?	St. Patrick's Oratory in O'Brien Hall
Who should come?	All individuals and families who are registered members of St. Patrick's Oratory (no pets please).
How much will the Photo Directory cost?	\$10.00 for a Photo Directory, if you have your picture taken \$15.00 for a Photo Directory, if you submit a photo \$20.00 for a Photo Directory, if your picture is not included in the Directory
How much are Photos?	There is no sitting fee. No purchase required. 8 Wallets ( $$20$ ), $4-3 \% \times 5 ($20$ ), $2-5 \times 7 ($25$ ), $11 \times 14 (40)$ , $16 \times 20 ($60)$ Digital images (up to 5 images with copyright release) $$100$
How long will it take?	Please allow 30-45 min. for your session. Families with 5 or more people will be scheduled for a longer photo session.
Can I submit my own photo?	Yes, you can. The cost of the Directory will be \$15.00. It is nicer to have all the same background and design in the Photo Directory so this is discouraged but allowed, if you can't make the photo sessions. Also, if you are submitting a professional photo, you must include a Publication Authorization form from the professional photographer.
Do I have control over what personal information I want included?	Absolutely. We will only print names underneath your photo and any information you wish in the back of the book where we will list contact information.
Will there be pressure sales?	No. There will not be any pressure sales. Prices for photo packages are reasonable. You will be shown your photos on a computer screen right after the Photo Session so you can determine if you would like to order any photos.
