Each of us, like the beloved who is proposed to, can accept or reject the proposal.

But whatever our decision, we will live with it forever.

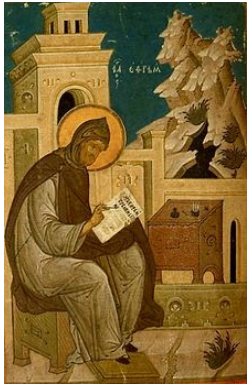

Saint Ephrem of Syria Tuesday, June 18 - 6:00 p.m. Mass

Poet, teacher, orator, and defender of the faith, Ephrem is the only Syriac Christian recognized as a doctor of the Church. He took upon himself the special task of opposing the many false doctrines rampant at his time, always remaining a true and forceful defender of the Catholic Church.

Born in Nisibis, Mesopotamia, he was baptized as a young man and became famous as a teacher in his native city. When the Christian emperor had to cede Nisibis to the Persians, Ephrem fled as a refugee to Edessa, along with many other Christians. He is credited with attracting great glory to the biblical school there. He was ordained a deacon but declined becoming a priest. Ephrem was said to have avoided presbyterial consecration by feigning madness!

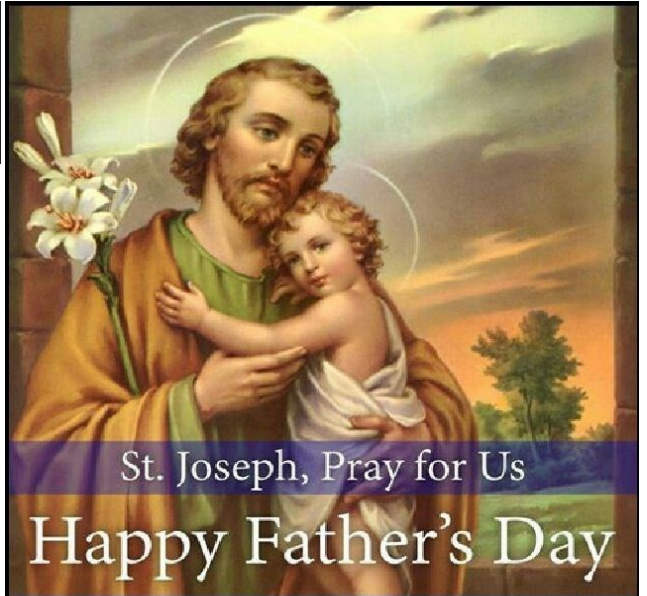
He had a prolific pen, and his writings best illumine his holiness. Although he was not a man of great scholarship, his works reflect deep insight and knowledge of the Scriptures. In writing about the mysteries of humanity's redemption, Ephrem reveals a realistic and humanly sympathetic spirit and a great devotion to the humanity of Jesus. It is said that his poetic account of the Last Judgment inspired Dante.

It is surprising to read that he wrote hymns against the heretics of his day. He would take the popular songs of the heretical groups and using their melodies, compose beautiful hymns embodying orthodox doctrine. Ephrem became one of the first to introduce song into the Church's public worship as a means of instruction for the faithful. His many hymns have earned him the title "Harp of the Holy Spirit."

Ephrem preferred a simple, austere life, living in a small cave overlooking the city of Edessa. It was here that he died around 373.

One of St. Ephrem's Quotes: "Do not look for the faults of your friend. Do not repeat the shortcomings of your neighbors in your talk. You are not the judge of creation. You do not have dominion over the earth. If you love righteousness, admonish your soul and yourself. Be the judge of your own sins, and chastise your own transgressions."

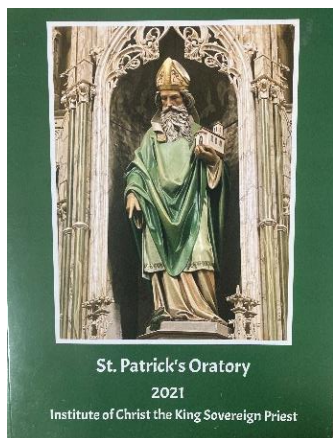

Canon Boucheron would like an updated St. Patrick's Oratory Photo Directory to be created, especially with all the new individuals and families at St. Patrick's Oratory since our last photo directory was done in 2021! In this directory, we will include the restoration projects of our beautiful church. We will be creating and printing our Photo Directory this year. Beth Relyea Photography (Oratory Member) has been hired to take the individual/family photos. This will allow us to be more flexible in days and times for Photo Sessions. Oratory members can expect a lower cost for the Photo Directory (which would be \$15) and less expensive photo options (see below).

Where will photos be taken?	St. Patrick's Oratory in O'Brien Hall
Who should come?	All individuals and families who are registered members of St. Patrick's Oratory (no pets please).
How much will the Photo Directory cost?	\$10.00 for a Photo Directory, if you have your picture taken \$15.00 for a Photo Directory, if you submit a photo \$20.00 for a Photo Directory, if your picture is not included in the Directory
How much are Photos?	There is no sitting fee. No purchase required. 8 Wallets (\$20), 4 – 3 ½ x 5 (\$20), 2 – 5 x 7 (\$25), 11 x14 (40), 16 x 20 (\$60) Digital images (up to 5 images with copyright release) \$100
How long will it take?	Please allow 30-45 min. for your session. Families with 5 or more people will be scheduled for a longer photo session.
Can I submit my own photo?	Yes, you can. The cost of the Directory will be \$15.00. It is nicer to have all the same background and design in the Photo Directory so this is discouraged but allowed, if you can't make the photo sessions. Also, if you are submitting a professional photo, you must include a Publication Authorization form from the professional photographer.
Do I have control over what personal information I want included?	Absolutely. We will only print names underneath your photo and any information you wish in the back of the book where we will list contact information.
Will there be pressure sales?	No. There will not be any pressure sales. Prices for photo packages are reasonable. You will be shown your photos on a computer screen right after the Photo Session so you can determine if you would like to order any photos.
