#### Introit

### Secret

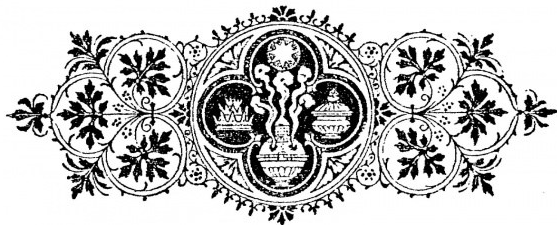
