Solemnity of St. Joseph

Introit

Our soul waiteth for the Lord: for he is our helper and protector. For in him our heart shall rejoice: and in his holy name we have trusted, alleluia, alleluia O thou that rulest Israel: thou that leadest Joseph like a sheep. Thou that sittest upon the cherubims, shine forth, alleluia, alleluia Glory be to the Father . . . Our soul waiteth . . .

Collect

O God, Who in Thine unspeakable foreknowledge didst choose Thy blessed servant Joseph to be the husband of Thine Own most holy Mother; mercifully grant that now that He is in heaven with Thee, we who on earth do reverence him for our defender, may worthily be helped by the succor of his prayers to Thee on our behalf. Who livest and reignest . . .

Almighty God, Who showest to them that be in error the light of thy truth, to the intent that they may return into the way of righteousness, grant unto all them that are admitted into the fellowship of Christ's Religion, that they may eschew those things that are contrary to their profession, and follow all such things as are agreeable to the same. Through the same Jesus Christ . . .

Epistle

Genesis 49:22-26

Joseph is a growing son, a growing son and comely to behold; the daughters run to and fro upon the wall. But they that held darts provoked him, and quarrelled with him, and envied him. His bow rested upon the strong, and the bands of his arms and his hands were loosed, by the hands of the mighty one of Jacob: thence he came forth a pastor, the stone of Israel. The God of thy father shall be thy helper, and the Almighty shall bless thee with the blessings of heaven above, with the blessings of the deep that lieth beneath, with the blessings of the breasts and of the womb. The blessings of thy father are strengthened with the blessings of his fathers: until the desire of the everlasting hills should come; may they be upon the head of Joseph, and upon the crown of the Nazarite among his brethren.

Alleluia

Alleluia, alleluia. In whatever tribulation they shall cry to Me, I shall hear them and be their protector always. Alleluia. Obtain for us, O Joseph, to lead an innocent life; and may it ever be safe through thy patronage. Alleluia.

Gospel

Luke 3:21-23

At that time, it came to pass, when all the people were baptized, that Jesus also being baptized and praying, heaven was opened; and the Holy Ghost descended in a bodily shape, as a dove upon Him; and a voice came from heaven: Thou art my beloved Son; in Whom I am well pleased. And Jesus Himself was beginning about the age of thirty years; being, as it was supposed, the son of Joseph.

Praise the Lord, O Jerusalem: praise thy God, O Sion. Because he hath strengthened the bolts of thy gates, he hath blessed thy children within thee, alleluia, alleluia.
