Pope Leo XIII decreed that this prayer be recited each day during the month of October after the recitation of the holy rosary

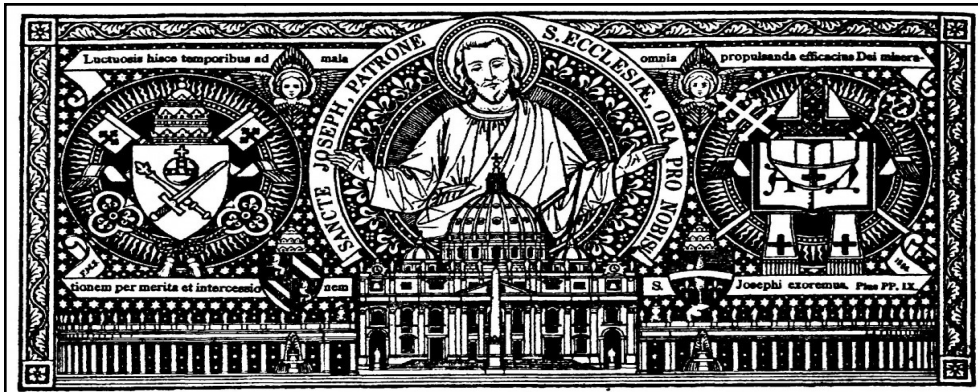
