Dear faithful,

We now begin the month of July, traditionally consecrated to the Most Precious Blood of Our Lord Jesus Christ. We celebrated the feast in honor of His Precious Blood this past Friday; the first day of the month. God in His infinite wisdom deemed it necessary that His Only-Begotten son shed every last drop of this blood for our salvation. Moreover, Christ Himself has assured us that the drinking of His Blood brings our salvation – “Except you eat the flesh of the Son of man, and drink his blood, you shall not have life in you” (John 6:54).

Patriots that we are, we will also celebrate our nation’s independence this Monday. In his July letter, Canon Matthew Talarico reminds us that for us Catholics, the first independence we give thanks for is that from the bondage of sin, won for us by Christ’s shedding of His blood:

“We remember how we have been freed from the bondage of sin, freed by our Redemption wrought by the shedding of the Most Precious Blood of Our Lord Jesus Christ! The remission of our sins sprung from the depths of the flames of charity burning in the Sacred Heart of Jesus, whose feast we celebrated only a week ago. And as fireworks will illuminate the night sky to the amazement of all watching, so too will the presence of the Sacred Heart, shedding from its wound the Precious Blood illuminate the faithful with a sign of hope in the abundance of God’s mercy.”

As this **Monday, July 4 is Independence Day**, many among you will probably be attending traditional barbecues and parties in the evening with family members and friends. Consequently, the **Mass will be celebrated at 12 noon**, rather than the usual 6 pm.

We welcome back an old familiar (though youthful) face this week-end: that of **Abbé Jacob Wells, whom you may now address as Deacon Wells!** Please be sure to greet him warmly and congratulate Deacon Wells on his ordination. Deo gratias! Continue to pray for our new deacon; he needs it now more than ever. We also welcome back **Abbé Alex Hoopes**, who will be with us for only a brief stay before heading off to Wausau, Wisconsin to help with the Institute's summer camps there.

With our emphasis on the familial nature of our community, the Institute of Christ the King, our superiors encourage us canons to make efforts to visit each other during the year and spend time with confreres we don’t necessarily see very often. **I will be traveling to Tucson, Arizona** the week after next (**Monday, July 11 – Saturday, July 16**) to spend several days with Canon Jonathan Fehrenbacher, the Rector St. Gianna Oratory. **Canon Bryan Silvey**, who serves as Canon Fehrenbacher’s vicar in Tucson, will replace me here in Oakland during this time.
