Dear faithful,

Saint Paul encourages us in these words today:

“Always in all my prayers making supplication for you all, with joy; For your communication in the gospel of Christ from the first day until now. Being confident of this very thing, that he, who hath begun a good work in you, will perfect it unto the day of Christ Jesus” (Phil. 1:4-6)

It is important for us to remember that while our efforts in the practice of virtue and the interior life may not produce the fruits we want, when we want them, we do not rely solely on ourselves.
