### SUNDAY, JUNE 2, 2024 EXT. SOLEMNITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI (We offer the Mass Propers in the Parish Bulletin)

#### Dear faithful,

We celebrate this Sunday the External Solemnity of Corpus Christi, the Body and Blood of Our Lord. Why did Our Lord not content Himself with the work of the Redemption, opening up the Gates of Heaven to us? Why was He not satisfied until He could come and dwell in us Body and Soul? Dom Guéranger gives us a hint in *The Liturgical Year*:

"Like every living creature around him, man thirsts for happiness; and yet he is the only creature on earth that feels within itself longings for what is immensely beyond its capacity. While docile to the lord placed over them by the Creator, the irrational creatures are quite satisfied with what they find in this world; they render to man their several services, and their own desires are all fully gratified by what is within their reach: it is not so with Man; he can find nothing in this his earthly dwelling which can satiate his irresistible longings for a something which this earth cannot give and which time cannot produce; for that something is the infinite."

Man has an appetite not just for earthly food, but for Heavenly Food, culminating in perfect union with the God who made Heaven and Earth. Our Lord Himself becomes this food for us in the Blessed Sacrament. Let us strive ever to receive Him with the holiest of dispositions. We will surely see the good fruits.

There will be the traditional <u>Eucharistic Procession and Benediction after the</u> 12:30 Mass this Sunday. Please plan accordingly for the longer ceremonies.

A **big thank you** to all who made **Monsignor Wach's visit** so special last week! Our gratitude goes out to Canon Talarico, as well, for all he did to facilitate Monsignor's visit. We had a pretty good turnout at both the Solemn Mass and the reception. Thank you to all who personally greeted and thanked Monsignor for guiding our dear institute all these years, and his care for our humble apostolate.

We begin the month of June, dedicated to the <u>Sacred Heart of Jesus</u>. Let us pray for the conversion of those who choose rather to dedicate this month to sin and vice. Surely, the treasures of His Sacred Heart include many graces of conversion for hardened hearts.

The Feast of the Sacred Heart is next <u>Friday, June 7</u>. There will be a <u>High</u> <u>Mass at 6 pm</u>, followed by Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, the Litany of the Sacred Heart, and the Act of Reparation to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. This prayer is attached in Flocknote.
