SUNDAY, JUNE 30, 2024 6TH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST (We offer the Mass Propers in the Parish Bulletin)

Dear faithful,

On this Sixth Sunday after Pentecost, Dom Guéranger reminds us in the *Liturgical Year* that seven is the number of divine rest, and that it is for this reason that Our Lord attributed the seventh beatitude to the peacemakers ("Blessed are the peacemakers...") in the Sermon on the Mount. This leads us to an interesting question – how is the quality of our rest? Is it truly a refreshment of our bodies and souls, or do we give ourselves over to vain amusements that only serve to tire us out more and expose us to dangerous situations? Remember that the day of rest par excellence is of course the Lord's Day, Sunday. After the Holy Mass, let us give pride of place to necessary repose, moderate recreation, and time spent with our loved ones.

This <u>Monday is July 1</u>, the Feast of the Most <u>Precious Blood</u> of Our Lord Jesus Christ. This is a first-class feast, all therefore who are capable are encouraged to assist at Holy Mass. One drop of Our Lord's Precious Blood would have sufficed infinitely for the redemption of our fallen race, but He insisted on giving all. Would you like to especially honor Our Lord during the month of July, dedicated to His Precious Blood? An excellent means of doing so is to recite the Litany of the Precious Blood.

The Prior General and co-founder of the Institute, <u>Monsignor Gilles Wach</u>, was received in a private audience with <u>His Holiness Pope Francis</u> this past Monday, June 24. It was a cordial meeting for the 45th anniversary of Monsignor's ordination to the priesthood by Pope St. John Paul II, and the occasion for Monsignor to thank Pope Francis for his letter *Totum amoris est*, dedicated to St. Francis de Sales, the principal Patron of our community. Pope Francis twice insisted during this meeting that the Institute of Christ the King continue to serve the Church according to its <u>own proper charism</u>.
