## SUNDAY, JULY 14, 2024 8TH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST (We offer the Mass Propers in the Parish Bulletin)

Dear faithful,

On this Eighth Sunday after Pentecost, Our Lord's advice is rather startling:

"I say to you: Make unto you friends of the mammon of iniquity, that when you shall fail, they may receive you into everlasting dwellings" (Luke 16;1 -9).

Could it be that the same Lord who asked us what fellowship the light has with the darkness is now going back on His word, and exhorting us to adopt the twisted morality of this world? No. But there is something we can learn from worldly contemporaries – prudence in how we manage our affairs, chiefly those pertaining to our eternal salvation, like our prayer life and our frequenting of the sacraments.

Let us not, as worldly souls do, devote all our time and talents to furthering our financial interests, but in applying the teachings of Our Lord in our lives more intelligently. Let those who have the means to give to the Church and their less fortunate neighbor give with generosity, and they will see that the most important returns await us in the next life.
