This week's bulletin message is provided by Canon Wells:

Dear Faithful,

Canon Norman has asked me to speak briefly about myself and my vocation to the priesthood and to the Institute of Christ the King. It is my honor, of course, to do so because before truly being about myself, my story, just like that of anyone else, is part of the story of Divine Providence.

I am a native of San Francisco: I spent my early years all the way up until my early twenties in the Bay Area. My family is not Catholic, so I had no religious upbringing and, as such, attended public schools all the way up until High School. However, for High School I attended Sacred Heart Cathedral Preparatory where I received a basic education in Catholicism. It was during this time that I converted to the Catholic Church, after having converted previously to a non-denominational Protestantism a few years prior. A good friend helped on the way to the Church, and he eventually was my sponsor for Confirmation in 2008.

After High School I attended UC Berkeley for mathematics; at least, that was the original idea. It was in my sophomore year that I discovered the Latin Mass at Saint Margaret Mary's church, at that time under the pastoral guidance of Fr. Zak and the late Canon Fragelli. Just before discovering the Latin Mass and the Institute, I had changed my major to Philosophy because I had already seriously considered entering the diocesan seminary. But, by the time that Canon Avis, Canon Meney, and Abbé Kevin came around, I was convinced that I could not enter anywhere other than the Institute's international seminary at Gricigliano. Above all, the Institute was not just a community that celebrated the Latin Mass, but truly a place that I could call home.

By the grace of God, I was ordained a priest in April of last year by His Eminence Raymond Leo Cardinal Burke, and am currently stationed in Saint Louis, Missouri, where abound copious number of faithful (in my first year I baptized twenty-one souls) who love the Institute and are very good to their priests. Please, pray for me and for the other Institute Canons who are about to see each other again in Gricigliano for our annual Chapter, and where we will receive our new assignments, or where we will find out that we will have the grace to stay put.

LET the receiving of Thy Body, O Lord Jesus Christ, which I presume to receive, though unworthy, turn not unto me for judgment and condemnation, but, according to Thy mercy, let it be profitable to me for the receiving of protection and healing, both of soul and body: Who livest and reignest for ever and ever. Amen.
