Next Sunday, July 2, is the fourteenth anniversary of the ordination of Canon Raphael Ueda to the priesthood. He and Canon Jason Apple were ordained by Cardinal Raymond Burke in 2009 at the church of St.Michael and Gaetano in Florence, Italy. Please pray for his perseverance in the Holy Priesthood.

Little Lesson in Church Music

Earlier in the Church's history there were more proper chants sung at Mass than there are now. The proper chants are generally taken from Holy Scripture, but the sequence is an exception: it frequently refers to Scripture but does not quote it. There are five sequences which remain: Victimae Pascale Laudes for Easter, Veni Sancte Spiritus for Pentecost, Lauda Sion Salvatorem for Corpus Christi, Dies Irae for All Souls, and Stabat Mater for the Seven Sorrows of Mary. The Stabat Mater has become the hymn sung during Stations of the Cross, but the melody of the Sequence is different from the melody of the hymn at Stations.


