It has been about a month since Abbe Morin went back to seminary in June. I am grateful to our Altar servers who committed to serving at a daily mass during that time. There has not been a day when no altar server showed up at mass this year. It is a great comfort to see their fidelity!

Tuesday, Abbe Robert Keller, originally of Ohio, arrived at San Jose. He has just completed his first year of seminary, receiving his cassock and being tonsured at the seminary in Florence, Italy, in the beginning of July. He will stay with us until August 11.

Abbe Keller told me that there are 24 other seminarians who received cassock with him this year. Among them there are many Americans and Frenchmen but also men from such countries as Italy, England, Netherlands, Romania, Guatemala. When I received a cassock in 2002, there were only five first-year seminarians. The growth in vocations is quite evident and impressive. This is a sure sign that God never abandons His Church. Let us continue to trust in the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of Mary, for in the end her Immaculate Heart will triumph.




