Little Lesson in Church Music

Many times, we think of music generally as being sung in unison or in four parts, feeling that any other arrangement is strange. But the treasury of Sacred Music contains countless examples of music for 2 or 3 voices, as well as for more than 4. Orlando Lassus wrote many duets. William Byrd, the English composer and contemporary of William Shakespeare and St.Francis de Sales, wrote Masses for three, four and five voices, among many other works. Thomas Tallis even wrote a famous piece called *Spem in Alium* for 40 voices. One special kind of two-part singing is called "organum", which you can recognize by its 'medieval' sound.
