At that time Jesus spoke to His disciples this parable: The kingdom of heaven is likened to a king, who would take an account of his servants. And when he had begun to take the account, one was brought to him that owed him ten thousand talents: and as he has not wherewith to pay it, his lord commanded that he should be sold, and his

wife and children, and all that he had, and payment to be made. But that servant falling down, besought him saying: Have patience with me, and I will pay thee all. And the lord of that servant, being moved with pity, let him go and forgave him the debt. But when that servant was gone out, he found one of his fellow-servants that owed him a hundred pence: and laying hold of him, he throttled him saying: Pay what thou owest. And his fellow-servant falling down besought him, saying Have patience with me, and I will pay thee all. And he would not; but went and cast him into prison till he paid the debt. Now his fellow-servants, seeing what was done, were very much grieved; and they came and told their lord all that was done. Then his lord called him, and saith to him: Thou wicked servant, I forgave thee all the debt, because thou besoughtest me; shouldst not thou then have had compassion also on thy fellow-servant, even as I had compassion on thee? And his lord being angry delivered him to the torturers until he paid all the debt. So also shall my heavenly Father do to you, if you forgive not every one his brother from you hearts.

The Month of the Poor Souls

In November, the Church reminds us of our duty to help the Poor Souls. Throughout the Octave of All Saints Day, November 1 through 8, we can gain a plenary indulgence for them by visiting a cemetery, praying for the faithful departed, and fulfilling the conditions for an indulgence (detachment from sin, confession within 8 days, reception of Holy Communion, and prayers for the Holy Father.) We can gain this indulgence once each day, during that week. On the table by the side door, there is a sign-up sheet so that you can request



prayers for your loved ones bv listing their names and the cemetery where thev are buried.

Our Guardian Angels



Some spiritual writers are of the opinion that the Guardian Angels inform the suffering Souls in Purgatory of the happenings in this world that would concern them. St. Augustine writes, "The departed may be informed by the Angels of things happening in the world, insofar as this is permitted by Him to whose judgment everything is subject."

It is believed also that the Angels reveal to the Poor Souls the benefactors who are assisting them by their prayers, and at the same time urge the suffering souls to pray for these good friends. There is a story of a Jesuit priest who would daily pray a rosary for the Poor Souls, but when one night he fell asleep having neglected to pray for them, his Guardian Angel awakened him, saying, "My son, the souls in Purgatory are awaiting the usual performance of your charity." When a suffering soul is to be released from Purgatory, the Guardian Angel of the happy soul is sent by God to descend immediately into Purgatory to open the doors of the prison and to deliver the soul forthwith into the eternal Paradise of Heaven


